Ken Bruce helps raise funds for Autistica at ICAP



Ken made a personal appearance at the largest fundraising event in the City of London, to help raise funds for Autistica.

Money raised on Wednesday 7th December during the annual Charity Day at ICAP is to be donated to a selection of about 20 charities in the UK, among them Autistica. This unique event takes place in ICAP office all around the world, where all the profits from trading on that day - as well as salaries - are handed over to chosen charities.

The money Autistica will receive will go towards a pioneering project to develop a new therapy to alleviate the symptoms of autism in the very young.

The project known as iBasis (Intervention – British Autism Study of Infant Siblings) is due to be launched in the New Year at Manchester University. It will aim to develop a preventative treatment for small babies known to be at risk of autism because an older sibling has already been diagnosed with the condition.
